After almost ten years of marketing our products we have had several customers tell us of all the other uses they have found for ODORZ. We decided to share some of them with you!

HAPPY CARPETS

Between me and my two daughters we have nine dogs at three homes. Anybody that has dogs knows that they can have mistakes on the carpet.

My carpet is at least 20 years old and I had dogs all my life, the last few years cleaning them with a carpet cleaner would NOT get rid of the smell in the mat under the carpet. So I contacted ODORZ and asked them if I could try it at home and if it would hurt the dogs paws, they said it would be okay. So I mixed up fresh water in the carpet cleaner with half a scoop of ODORZ. WOW! The next day NO smell at all. NONE. So I passed it on to my kids to try... It works perfect. My daughter has four pups now and she makes some up in a squirt bottle LOL but it WORKS, hope this helps anyone.

DIRECTIONS FOR CARPET AND FARBIC

If using a carpet cleaner machine, use no more than one ounce to one gallon of water. Go over carpet with mixture, then again with plain water. If spot spraying mix up to one ounce per 16 ounce bottle for really tough jobs. Spray wet, let sit for two to three minutes and wipe well with a damp cloth.

LITTER BOXES

We have received letters from a number of cat owners that have told us they sprinkle it on the surface of their litter boxes and it eliminates all the odor and does not bother their cats. They use one to two scoops depending on the size of the litter box. They have also been able to extend the use of the litter by adding some if necessary. Note: do not mix into the litter, the cat will do that.

DOG GETS SPRAYED BY SKUNK

Deb from Edson said her dog has been sprayed by a skunk three times and that ODORZ works the very best to get rid of the odor.

First wash the pet with blue Dawn dish soap to break down the oily part of the spray. Then mix 1 oz of ODORZ with a gallon of warm water and wash the dog. Just keep out of pets eyes. Rinse and dry with a towel. No more odor on the pet. You may need to spray or sprinkle the area where the skunk sprayed.

WASHING MACHINE AND DISHWASHER

A gentleman from Calgary puts a scoop in his washing machine and also the dishwasher about twice a year. He says it removes the scum and leaves a nice fresh smell.

FRIDGE ODORS

Renters moved out and left food in the refrigerator for weeks before the owner found it. He put half a scoop in a spray bottle, gave it a heavy spray job and left it for a few days. We he came back and opened it, no smell at all.

HUNTERS
